Purpose: intervention program for reading and progress monitoring.
Time: 30-60 minutes
Results: Shared at fall parent conferences.
- Amplify & Dibels**
Purpose: Screening tool for Dyslexia and measures fluency.
Time: 30 minutes

- 11 **Pre LevelSet-Achieve 3000– Reading support program.** (K-12)
Purpose: To establish student individual Lexile level to provide appropriate level of instruction and target instruction.

Results: Teachers discuss with students and results are mailed home.
- 21 **ACT + Writing grade 11:** ACT College and Career Readiness System, online
Purpose: Measures student academic college readiness. State required opportunity to take the ACT + Writing for all juniors.
Time: 4 hours, online
Results: Results are mailed to students' home by ACT.
